Safety First

Here are our weekly safety tips that parents, guardians and staff should follow:

- ▶ Students arriving to Tyler between

8:00am and 8:20am each day should be dropped off in the Cafeteria. Breakfast is available for all students at this time. At approximately 8:20am, older students (1st-5th) begin moving to the Auditorium. Older students arriving after 8:20am should be escorted directly to the Auditorium. All others should be dropped off in the Cafeteria.

- ▶ Tyler staff on duty are responsible for students between 8:00am and 8:45am in the Cafeteria or Auditorium. (During this time, Tyler teachers and counselors are in team meetings, not on duty for student care. Tyler Front Office staff has duty in the Front Office.)
